Exam (exam taking, description of the written/oral/practical part of the exam, point distribution, grading criteria):

Students are continually evaluated during the course and can collect a maximum of 100 grade points (70 during classes and 30 on the final exam).

The course consists of 5 hours of lectures and 20 hours of seminars (max. 60 points). Students will present orally one topic and collect 30 points, the same topic they will submit in written form which will be valued also with 30 points. Attendance on classes will be valued 10 points. The student must collect at least 40 points to earn the right to access the final exam.

Final exam is in a form of written test with maximum of 30 point. Grade points achieved on the exam are combined with the points achieved in class and form the final grade.
